

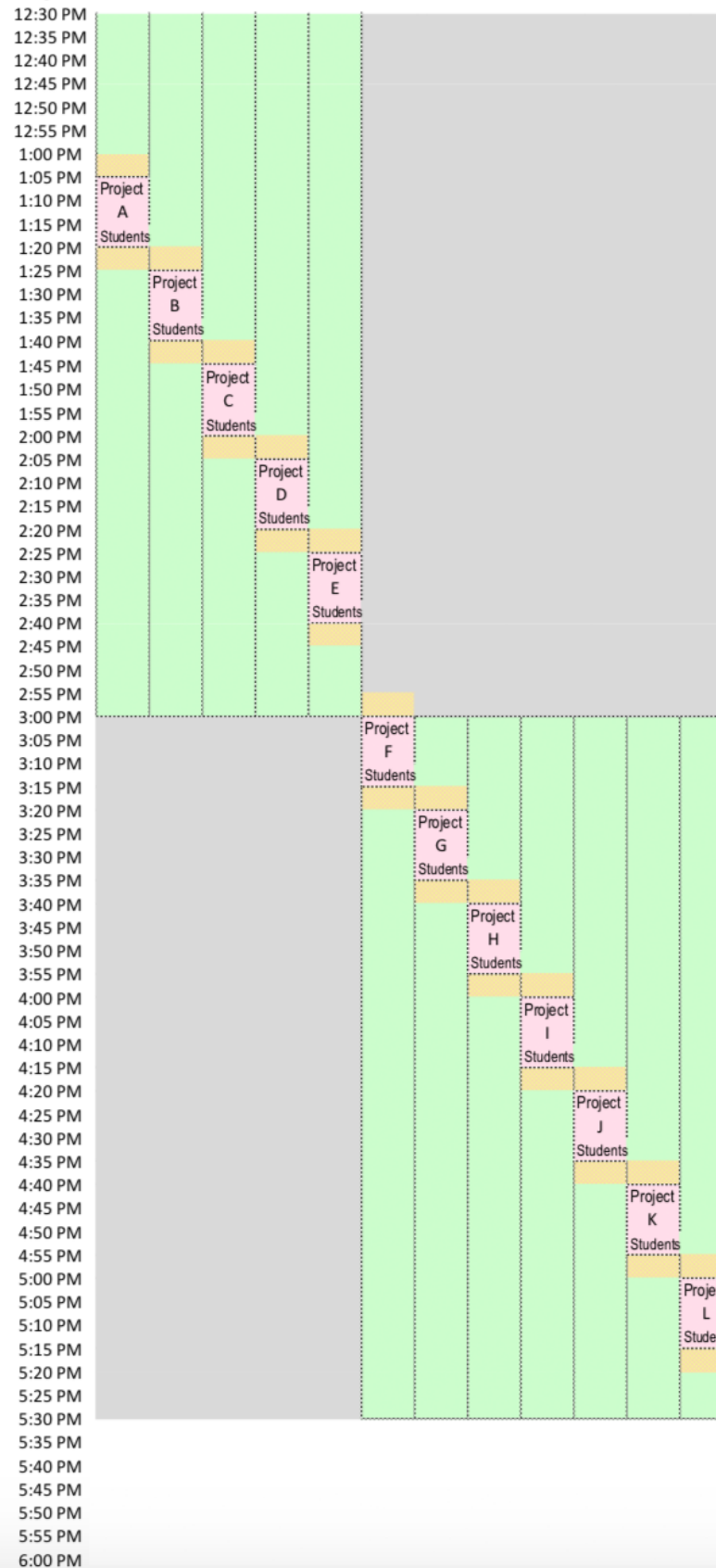
PROJECT JUDGING (EXAMPLE)

View of the individual Project Video Conferences for 12 different projects.
 -During the pink colored times, the student(s) will be in the Category judging conference for their interview with the Category judging team.
 -During the orange and pink colored times, the student(s) will not be available for Special Award judging.
 -During the green colored times, the student(s) will be in their project specific conference, available for Special Awards judging.
 -Category judging teams judge 8 to 12 assigned projects.

Student(s) from Project B	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> •Category Judging Teams <ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Stay in one video conference while student(s) move in and out by their project numbers. * Only interview student(s) of projects assigned to them. * Category judges will have a 20 minutes break from 2:40 - 3:00 PM.

break	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> •Special Awards Judging <ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Move in and out of the Project video conferences that they are interested in interviewing. * Interview as many or as few projects as they wish. Judges from different Special Awards may be interviewing the same project's student(s) at the same time. * Can take breaks whenever they want to, but must visit students during the students' assigned time of 2.5 hours
Student(s) from Project F	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students <ul style="list-style-type: none"> * Will have to attend two different video conferences for their project--one for Category judging and one for all Special Award judging. * Should stay in their project video conference for their 2.5 allotted hours, except when they leave for their Category Judging appointed time. * Each project will have one and only one Category judging interview with all their Category judges in the same video conference. * The number of special award interviews varies by the subject matter of the project, so many projects won't have any special award judges visiting their video conference.
