This year has presented a unique learning opportunity for all participants. How a vaccine was developed in record time because it was based on research that had been previously completed on other, similar viruses. It shows how science builds on itself for the betterment of all.

They worked hard and put time and energy into creating a fulfilling experience for everyone. While we were not able to hold an "in-person" Championship, I think the goal of recognizing student scientific discovery will be accomplished. As with many other events and competitions, ISEF 2020 showcased as a virtual event. This was my first year having one of my own students qualify, and although we were a little heartbroken that we would not be able to travel to the physical competition and experience the fair week, it did not detract from the rewarding feeling associated with that honor. Students worldwide submitted videos of themselves dancing for the opening session video montage and Maya Ajmera, CEO of the Society and Science for the Public and the Publisher of ScienceNews magazine, welcomed us to the event.

The Regeneron ISEF was held on a conference platform that allowed attendees to behave as an in-person event, including interactive chats at exhibit booths, workshops, and network with fellow research mentors. The week offered talks from Nobel Laureates, representatives from the USPTO and leaders of STEM entrepreneurship. I was invited to present in a teacher workshop session alongside colleagues from Arizona and Missouri. Each of us discussed one piece of "Teaching Research for Students". Despite the different demographics of students with whom we work, we found similarities in their needs and opportunities that we can provide them.

Even though the projects entered into ISEF represents a year's worth of work for students and their mentors, it is more than just an end goal of affiliated science fairs. The ISEF experience is a refreshing culmination that helps us to realize no matter how our students fare or which of our students even qualified, there is value in the STEM community that grows from it. 


